

Sports Photo Workshop @ 2010 Bay Area Senior Games

Inspired by the interest in sports photography, the inaugural annual Sports Photography workshop will be part of the 2010 Bay Area Senior Games.

April 10 – 11: Bay Area Senior Games – 2 full days of shooting at the Games

April 21: Portfolio review – 7 pm – 9 pm.

SPORTS PHOTOGRAPHY

This course will cover the basic principles involved in capturing compelling sports images. Subject areas include:

- Timing
- Camera settings
- Lighting
- Software
- Techniques of capturing the emotion and drama in everyday sport

Learn the camera settings necessary to capture peak action and deal with difficult lighting situations. Learn the basics of lighting a sports portrait with a hands-on portrait shoot onsite.

Guest photo coaches will include Bay Area professionals showing off the tools they use to capture dramatic sports images. Students will produce action images over the weekend of shooting for review, and the class will produce an online portfolio as a final project. The classroom will be the 2010 Senior Games held at Stanford University. <http://www.bayareaseniorgames.org>

Students should own a 35 mm digital camera, or have access to one, to take full advantage of this course.

This course will be led by [John Todd](#) and co-taught by Don Feria, wire service photographer and Nhat Meyer, San Jose Mercury News photographer – both Feria and Meyer will have just returned from photographing the 2010 Vancouver Olympic Winter Games.
